book or song, an inspirational quote, a funny picture, your favorite color, etc. Embellishments welcome. Just have fun!

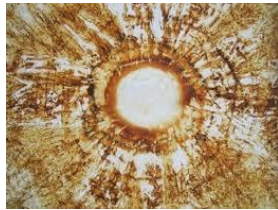
