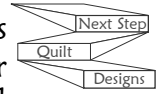


# Oatmeal Raisin - 57"x75"

**NOTE:** Unless otherwise instructed, sew all pieces right sides together, RST, with a  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam.

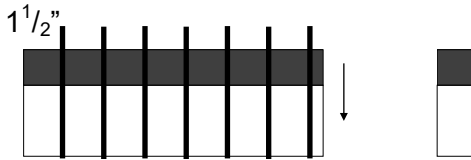
1. Cut the following fabrics and place each in their separate bag:

Fabric	Cut	Bag
Background <b>B</b>	[ 4 ] $9\frac{1}{2}$ " strips	1
Background <b>B</b>	[ 17 ] $3\frac{1}{2}$ " strips	2

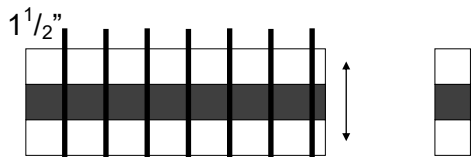
2. Cut the following fabrics:

Fabric	Cut
Background <b>B</b>	[ 7 ] $2\frac{1}{2}$ " strips [ 8 ] $1\frac{1}{2}$ " strips
Dark <b>D</b>	[ 11 ] $1\frac{1}{2}$ " strips

3. Make [ 7 ] strip sets using [ 1 ]  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " **B** strip and [ 1 ]  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " **D** strip in each strip set. Press to **B**. Should be  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " wide. Then cut into [ 180 ]  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " units. Put into **Bag 3**.



4. Make [ 4 ] strip sets using [ 2 ]  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " **B** strips and [ 1 ]  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " **D** strip in each strip set. Press to **B**. Should be  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " wide. Then cut into [ 108 ]  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " units. **If fabric is not  $40\frac{1}{2}$ " usable (selvedges not included) wide to cut [ 27 ]  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " units from each strip set, you may need to cut and make a partial strip set.**



5. Sew [ 1 ] Step 3 unit from **Bag 3** to [ 1 ] Step 4 unit. Press to Step 3. Should be  $2\frac{1}{2}$ "x $3\frac{1}{2}$ ". Make 108 units. Put into **Bag 4**.
