
## Oatmeal Raisin - 57"×75"

NSQ231501

**NOTE:** Unless otherwise instructed, sew all pieces right sides together, RST, with a  $^{1}/_{4}$ " seam.




Fabric	Cut	Bag
Background <b>B</b>	[ 4 ] 9 <sup>1</sup> / <sub>2</sub> " strips	1
Background <b>B</b>	[ 17 ] 3 <sup>1</sup> / <sub>2</sub> " strips	2

2. Cut the following fabrics:

Fabric	Cut
Background <b>B</b>	[7] 2 <sup>1</sup> / <sub>2</sub> " strips [8] 1 <sup>1</sup> / <sub>2</sub> " strips
Dark <b>D</b>	[ 11 ] 1 <sup>1</sup> / <sub>2</sub> " strips

3. Make [7] strip sets using [1]  $2^{1/2}$  B strip and [1]  $1^{1/2}$  D strip in each strip set. Press to B. Should be  $3^{1}/2$ " wide. Then cut into [ 180 ]  $1^{1}/2$ " units. Put into **Bag** 3.



4. Make [4] strip sets using [2]  $1^{1}/_{2}$  B strips and [1]  $1^{1}/_{2}$  D strip in each strip set. Press to B. Should be  $3^{1}/2^{\circ}$  wide. Then cut into [ 108 ]  $1^{1}/2^{\circ}$  units. If fabric is not  $40^{1}/2^{\circ}$  usable (selvedges not included) wide to cut [ 27 ] 1<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" units from each strip set, you may need to cut and make a partial strip set.



5. Sew [1] Step 3 unit from **Bag** 3 to [1] Step 4 unit. Press to Step 3. Should be  $2^{1}/2$ "x $3^{1}/2$ ". Make 108 units. Put into Baq 4.
