January 23, February 27, June 25 (Annual Picnic), August 28, November 27 Annual Holiday Party.

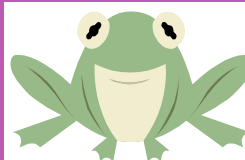
## Executive Committee 2018
