Flying Horse Farms Block of the Month

Each month (from January to April) instructions will be provided for a Block of the Month. Participants will complete one or more blocks by the next meeting. These blocks will be collected and packaged into quilt top kits to be completed at guild sew-ins.

JANUARY - Winter Blues Blocks (due Feb.)

FEBRARY — Cathedral Blocks (due March)

Flying Horse Farms Quilts (due by August 22 nd)

We have a goal of 30 quilts for Flying Horse Farms. The pattern book will be available if you are looking for inspiration. Quilt requirements are noted below:

Completed rectangular quilts that will be used on twin size bunk beds; ideal size is approximately 58"x 68" after it has been quilted and bound. No smaller than 55" X 65", no larger than 65" X 75." A completed quilt consists of a top, batting, and backing.

Edges bound with an attached binding. We are more in need of boys quilts for ages 14-17, than girls quilts.

UFO Challenge (due at monthly meetings)

Complete a UFO and get an entry to ticket into a quarterly drawing for a major award. Each completed UFO earns a ticket. The first drawing is in March. The prize basket is *Tools of the Trade.*



The February basket is Love is in the Air. Lots of goodies that are sure to steal your heart! The love basket is filled with books, fabric, notions, and of course candy. The drawing

will be at the end of the meeting. Tickets are \$1 or 6 for \$5.
