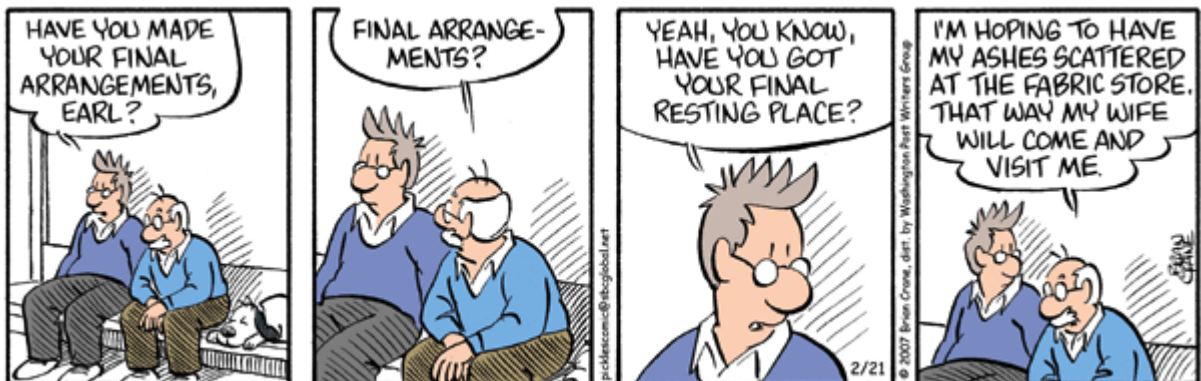

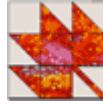

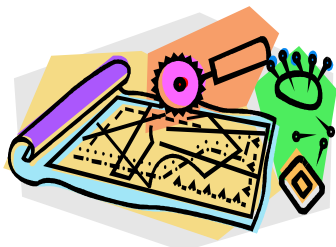
We will have extra packets available so if you did not sign up at the February meeting - you still have the opportunity to join us. Hope you will join in on the fun. Thank you.
