## National Fritter Day — December 2



Today is *National Fritters Day*, a December 2 holiday. Aren't we all lucky that this special day has finally arrived!? It's a food holiday and a good-tasting one at that. Ancient Greeks and Romans first made them. Their versatility allows you to make them with just about any foods. Typically, they include fruit, meats, seafood, or vegetables.
